

This year we will be distributing four (nonperishable extra meals) in the month of November to all of our Home Delivered Meal clients. It is important because these meals are designed to be used in the event that we are closed due to an emergency or weather related condition. These meals are **NOT** to be consumed right away but used as a ration.






